

1 Killed, 1 Hurt In Bootleg Mine Cave-In

WILKES-BARRE, April 16—(AP)—One man was killed and another seriously injured early today in a "bootleg" mine cave-in at Franklin stripping of the Lehigh Valley Coal company in Wilkes-Barre, near here.

Jacob Wasnalas of Georgetown, father of five children and four stepchildren, was buried in the cave-in and killed.

A volunteer crew of 20 men worked eight hours to free Wasnalas and his companion, Paul Zianas, also of Georgetown, who was taken to a Wilkes-Barre hospital.
