

# Young Miner Is Rescued From Bootleg Coal Hole

Pottsville, Pa., Aug. 10 (AP)—Raymond Levashausky, 21, was rescued tonight from a "bootleg" coal hole six hours after it collapsed on him. The trapped miner sustained life and avoided injury by clinging to a pocket in the side of the shaft. A companion, working at the surface, brought aid. The accident occurred at Greenbury, five miles from here.
