shaft and fastened the rope around Umlauf's body. After the body was hoisted to the surface, rescue crews dropped the rope to Wolfgang, who tied it around himself and started the ascent.

Rescuers had pulled Wolfgang up to within fifteen or twenty feet of the mouth of the shaft when they felt the rope becoming tight. Upon investigation, they discovered that the rope was tangled in a ladder and it required ten minutes before it was possible to free Wolfgang. Finally,

when they hoisted Wolfgang to the surface he was dead.

It is believed that the mask slipped off Wolfgang's face while he was being hoisted up the shaft.

Born in Lavelle, Wolfgang was a son of the late Felix and Marie (Welker) Wolfgang. He was a member of the Evangelical Church and the P. O. S. of A.

The funeral will be held Monday. Umlauf i: survived by his widow, the former Carrie Starr; one son, one daughter and two brothers.
