

Miner Rescued After Explosion and Fire

WALKER MINE, Calif. —(U.P.)—
Ross Nicely, 45-year-old miner,
was rescued yesterday from the
burning Walker mine after two
other men were brought to safety
earlier.

Nicely emerged from the mine at 1 p.m. with a rescue crew consisting of seven Grass Valley miners and three company men. The crew was the second to go into the shafts after the explosion and fire was discovered at 5:30 a.m.
