

# Body Of Miner Is Recovered

**Buddy Rescued  
An Hour After  
Trapped By Chute  
Cave-in Friday**

Work was resumed today at the Coaldale colliery of the Lehigh Navigation Coal Company after a general suspension as employes unsuccessfully attempted to rescue a miner trapped at the bottom of Shaft Number Nine.

The body of Joseph Bennis, 51, of Owl Creek, near Tamaqua, finally was recovered by rescue workers last night.

Bennis and Alex Petroskey, 61, of Lansford, were trapped by a chute cave-in Friday morning. Petroskey was rescued an hour later and taken to Coaldale Hospital, where he reportedly was recovering from a pelvis fracture.

Although they worked in continuous relays, the rescue squad was unable to reach Bennis' body until last night.
