

## ENTOMBED FOR 10 HOURS, ONEIDA MINER IS RESCUED

James Houser, 26, of Onedia, is recovering at the Hazleton State Hospital from shock, exposure and contusions of the left leg suffered during a 10-hour entombment in a coal hole.

Caught at 1:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon when a cable broke, causing the buggy to pull out timber which closed a slope, Houser was rescued before 11 o'clock last night.

He was working with his brother Henry, and Oscar Logan and was just winding up his coal hole job when the accident occurred. He was to begin a job at Audenried on Monday.
