The terrific explosion that rocked the entire Lehigh Valley yesterday morning was followed by the death of the 31 men employed in the Sands Eddy quarry of the Lehigh Portland Cement Co. and reduced to a shambles quarry buildings in the immediate vicinity of the explosion. The picture at upper left shows a wrecked drilling machine. A corrugated iron building on the floor of the quarry is shown in the photograph at lower left. The upper right picture shows rescue workers removing bodies of those who lost their lives. The mighty force of the explosion almost totally wrecked the two trucks shown in the lower right photo. These trucks were standing at the rim of the quarry.
