

TRAPPED MINERS RESCUED UNHURT

CANON CITY, Colo. Jan. 22 (U.P.)
—Three coal miners—trapped 2,000 feet underground by a cavein—were rescued unhurt late yesterday.

Drillers bored through more than 20 feet of solid rock to reach the trapped trio.

The men, trapped in a tunnel of the Griffiths coal mine four miles east of Canon City, were imprisoned less than three hours. The three trapped miners were Sam Bowman, George Costatino and Joe Fazzino.
