

Trapped 56 Hours, 2 Miners Rescued

Renton, Wash.—(AP)—Two miners were rescued last night from a coal mine gallery 350 feet under ground where they had been trapped for 56 hours by a cave-in.

Hungry, but evidently unhurt, the miners, Archie Skiver, 40, and Robert Stonack, 20, were freed through a tunnel dug around the slide. They came through the tunnel unassisted but were taken to a hospital for observation. The only food they had since Friday morning was what rescue workers had been able to send down a 60-foot two-inch pipe driven to a point near the men.
