

Negro Mine Blast Hero Fatally Hurt

MADISONVILLE, Ky., Dec. 19.—
(Special)—W. R. Moore, Providence, Negro, hero of the rescue of a dozen miners from West Kentucky Coal company mine No. 10 on Nov. 10, is dead.

He was fatally injured when crushed between his mine motor and the top of an entry. He died yesterday at an Evansville hospital.

After the explosion at the mine he ran his motor through a field of lethal gas, loaded miners aboard, and dashed through the gas to safety.
