

## MINER RESCUED FROM COAL HOLE

Anthony Onushak, 35, of Brad-donville, near Ringtown, was res-cued yesterday from a bootleg mine operation near Mahanoy City, after he was entombed more than five hours.

Onushak was working alone at the bottom of a 400-foot slope when the workings closed as the result of a heavy fall on the slope. Fellow independent miners organized a rescue force and found the miner buried to his hips, but not badly injured. He refused medical atten-tion after his rescue, and at his re-quest was taken to his home.
