

BOY RESCUED FROM SCRANTON MINE CAVE

Seven-year-old Edward Pall, West Scranton, appeared little the worse yesterday at his home following his rescue from a mine cave hole which held him prisoner for nearly two hours. The boy was on his way to school and walking along a path through a field near his home when the earth gave way and swallowed him to his shoulders.

Nearly two hours later, his father, Charles Pall, on his way to work heard the boy's cries and saw his head sticking out of the ground. After digging frantically Pall rescued his son and carried him home. Examination of the youngster showed he was unhurt, but suffering somewhat from shock.

Police said the cave was four feet deep.
