

Sixth Person Dies From Mine Blast

KENILWORTH, Carbon County —Funeral services were being arranged Saturday for six victims of an explosion Wednesday at the Independent Coal & Coke Co. mine while five others injured in the blast were reported in "poor" condition at Price and Kenilworth hospitals.

Sixth person to die of burns suffered in the accident was David Bennett, 27, Kenilworth, who died at 8:30 p. m. Friday.

Miners who have died previously are Arthur William Smith, Iven Jensen, Gilmer Nielsen, Clem Hawks and Ivan Russell Jackson.

Still hospitalized and being treated for severe burns are Richard Farrimond, Arthur Lermusiaux, Nick Markakis, George Archibque and Felipe Armizo.

Operations at the mine remained at a standstill and operators said they could not determine when men would return to work.
