

Woman, 57, Pulled From 25-Foot Mine Cave-in Pit

Pittston, Pa., May 2 —(AP)— A 57-year-old mother of 11 children was rescued today from a 25-foot pit after a section of her yard subsided as she stepped from the rear porch of her home.

The woman, Mrs. Clayton M. Ryce, was rescued by her husband and neighbors after suffering lacerations and contusions.

The Ryce home is located over abandoned mine workings near the scene of a former mine-subsidence which claimed the life of a five-year-old boy.
