Art Henderson, about 36, 384 West 2nd North, was treated for asphyxiation when overcome by carbon-monoxide gas in a mine about 30 miles east of here in Logan canyon. A rescue squad from Logan-Cache fire department consisting of chief E. S. Lawrence, and firemen Clyde Cressall and Heber Corbridge, answered the call with the respiration materials. Mr. Henderson was reported as resting "good" at his home by the attending physician, Dr. Omer Budge.
