

Youth Rescued From Mine Hole

Andrew Cooper, 16, of Pottsville, had a narrow escape from death on Thursday night at 10 o'clock when he rode his bicycle into a caved-in mine. He landed on a ledge 50 feet from the top, but the bike plunged another 200 feet to the bottom of the mine, believed to be filled with water.

He managed to scale halfway up a wall only to lose his grip and plunge once again to the ledge. Searchers heard his shouts five hours later and hoisted him to the top with a rope.
