EUREKA, Utah (AP)—Two silver miners were freed Saturday night by crews who shoveled through 100 tons of dirt for almost eight hours after a slide of waste matter trapped the pair. Fifteen fellow miners used a bucket machine and shovels to reach Bryan Sorenson and Benny Allison, trapped in a mine pocket at the 1300-foot level of the Gemini mine from 1 p. m. to 8:45 p. m.
