

Blind Miner Rescued In S. L. Canyon Slide

Survivor of a terrible experience, trapped by a huge avalanche he could not see, but only hear, Roy Newman, blind miner, was discovered Friday afternoon in the area of the snowslide which thundered down into Big Cottonwood canyon Thursday afternoon.

Searchers for Mr. Newman and three skiers who were unaccounted for after the snow mass blocked the canyon road and stream, found the miner hiding in one of the mine shafts which honeycomb the area. He was shaken, but unhurt, rescuers reported.

Fears for Mr. Newman's safety had risen earlier in the afternoon when state troopers slogged through heavy snow and found his cabin intact, but vacant. A friend of the blind man, who assisted in the search, suggested Mr. Newman might be in one of the mine shafts or tunnels, and a search of these revealed the missing man.
