

Miner Is Rescued From Muck Cave-In

KELLOGG, Idaho, Nov. 18. (AP)—George A. Scheurich, Kellogg, is recovering today in a local hospital after being buried for four hours yesterday under seven feet of muck in a chute at the John George lease mill in Wardner.

Fellow millmen and Bunker Hill employees rescued him by tearing out the sides of the ore chute.

Scheurich was alone when the accident occurred and it is believed he was walking on top of the muck when it started to roll.

He was uninjured, but suffered from cold and cramp and is being kept in the hospital for observation.
