

## TWO ACCIDENT VICTIMS IN HINTON HOSPITAL

HINTON, Nov. 17—Two victims of accidents were receiving treatment at the Hinton Hospital today.

Eight-year-old Franklin Lilly, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Lilly, of Rainelle, suffered a broken right arm in a fall at the school playground Wednesday afternoon.

Howard Daniels, 41, of Beelick Knob, is receiving treatment at the hospital, after being removed from under a slate fall this morning at the Alaska Coal company, where he was trapped for about three hours. He was to be X-rayed for possible fractures, but the extent of his injuries were not fully determined this afternoon, although he suffered shock and exposure.
