RUSSELTON, Pa. —(UP)— Two coal miners, Lloyd Collier, Sr., 68, Rural Ridge, and John L. Karolewicz, 43, West Brownsville, were killed yesterday in mine accidents. Both were victims of roof cave-ins.

Collier, whose grandson, Donnie Collier, disappeared three years ago from his parents cabin in Kooser State Park and was never found, died of suffocation when a roof collapsed on him inside Republic Steel Corporation's No. 3

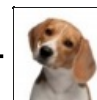
VERY FISHY STORY
