FIFTH EXPLOSION VICTIM DIES IN WILKES-BARRE

George Miller, 33, of Bear Creek, yesterday became the fifth fatality resulting from a gas explosion on March 29 in the Inman shaft of the Glen Alden Coal Co. in Hanover township near Wilkes-Barre.

He died at 7:30 a. m. in the General Hospital, Wilkes-Barre.

Two men were killed instantly in the blast, and seven others were injured. Of the seven hospitalized, three have died of their injuries and the fourth man, James Hoison, of Hanover township, was reported in critical condition yesterday.
