

Miner Buried 6 Hours

Pottsville, April 28 (AP)—A 44-year-old miner was buried up to the neck in a pile of coal for six hours today before rescuers could set him free.

Thomas Margelavage of New Philadelphia, one of four operators of an independent mine, was set free only 20 hours after the body of another miner had been recovered from a nearby mine.

Margelavage was taken to Good Samaritan Hospital, where he is being treated for cuts, bruises and shock.

Mine Inspector Timothy Ryan said a wall of coal collapsed and buried Margelavage.
