

2 Youths Rescued. From Mine Shaft

PUEBLO, Colo. (AP)—Two teenage boys spent seven hours at the bottom of an abandoned mine shaft Friday after their jeep plunged 60 feet into the opening.

James McCarty, 14, of Pueblo, and his cousin, Robert Roblek, 15, suffered severe cuts.

The boys were dumping trash. The youngsters said they rounded a hill near the dump and spotted the hole. McCarty, who was driving, attempted to apply the brakes, but the jeep skidded downhill into the shaft.

David Riggs, a game warden, and William McCarty, James' father, lifted out both the boys and the wrecked jeep with a winch.
