Miner's Wife Leads Rescue

TALACHE, Idaho, May 29.

(AP)—Three miners were rescued unburt today by a shovel-wielding miner's wife after the trio had been trapped by a cave-in 75 feet from the mouth of a side-hill claim near this old mining community on Lake Pend Oreille, Bonner county, sheriff's officers reported.

They said Mrs. Floyd Watts grabbed a shovel and headed into the tunnel for the eight-footwide cave-in while her busband hurried to a phone at a lake resort to call for help.
