# Jefferson Miner Is Killed At Clyde

A Jefferson miner was killed in a slate fall this morning in the Clyde 1 Mine of Republic Steel Corp. at Fredericktown.

The victim was Earl Jenkins, 63, who had worked at the mine for about 30 years.

He was a general inside laborer and was working on ventilation brattices at the time of death.

The accident occurred about 2 a.m. The body was taken to the John Lucas Funeral Home at Jefferson.

Information about the victim's survivors could not immediately be obtained. He is reportedly survived by his wife and several grown children.
