

Youth Rescued From Mine Tunnel

PUTNAM VALLEY, N.Y. (AP)
—A state trooper today trudged a thousand feet through an abandoned mine tunnel to reach an injured youth trapped in a 200-foot-deep shaft, then piggy-backed the victim to safety.

The youth, Gerald Kulich, 18, of nearby Peekskill, fell into the shaft while exploring the old iron mine with four other teen-agers. Kulich already was half-buried in falling debris as his companions ran to a nearby home, where police were called.
