

TUNNEL WORKER RESCUED; ANOTHER PRESUMED DEAD

PARKERSBURG, W.Va., June 8 (AP)—Workers picked their way through rock falls yesterday and rescued a construction worker who was pinned under tons of rock that crashed from the roof of a Baltimore & Ohio railroad tunnel.

The rescued worker is Arthur Boggs of Greenville, W.Va. one of the nine workmen in the tunnel when the fall occurred, Harry Nichols of Bartlett, O., was missing and presumed dead.
