End of Search For Girl's Body Results in Strike

CALUMET, Mich. (AP) — Workers at the Calumet Division of Calumet & Hecla, Inc., staged a short strike Wednesday, protesting the end of the search for a 7-year-old girl.

The girl, Ruth Ann Miller, fell into one of the company's abandoned mines Saturday. The search was called off Tuesday. It had become apparent that the lives of miners trying to find her body were endangered by the deteriorated condition of the mile-deep mine shaft.

Hope for the girl's life was abandoned earlier.

Miners walked off their jobs earlier Wednesday, but returned after talking with union and company officials and learning of a letter from the girl's family.

Ruth Ann's stepfather, Eugene Taylor, wrote:

"Mrs. Taylor and I are deeply disturbed by reports of dissatisfaction by some people with the decision to discontinue efforts to recover our daughter. This decision was reached jointly by ourselves and mining company and government safety experts. We are aware and deeply grateful that the rescuers were willing to continue the great personal risk. But fear
