

Man Dies In Mine Accident

Karol K. Kerin Jr., 55, of near Edenborn, was killed yesterday in a mine fall at the McGee Coal Co. mine at Continental No. 3.

Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m. Monday at the T. Leonard Sangston Funeral Home, McClellandtown, where friends may call after 7:30 this evening. Burial will be in Church Hill Cemetery, McClellandtown, with the Rev. H. L. Davis officiating.

The German Twp. man was injured at about 11:15 a.m. when he was caught by a side fall. He was pronounced dead on arrival at Uniontown Hospital an hour later.

Mine officials said other men in the area at the time of the fall were not injured.

Mr. Kerin had been employed a little over a year at the mine, owned by George H. McGee of 52 Evans St., Uniontown.
