

Girl, 17, Rescued From Mine Shaft

Salt Lake City (AP) — A high school girl with a yen to explore caves was rescued from the bottom of a 150-foot mine shaft yesterday where she had fallen not once but twice.

Melaine Beck, 17 yesterday was lifted from the near-vertical shaft by deputy sheriffs using ropes and a basket stretcher. It took nearly two-and-a-half hours to bring her out.

Melanie suffered a broken arm, head lacerations and a possible concussion in the fall.
