

One Dead Rock Fall Injures Local Man

James Nagy, 25, of Connellsville, is in guarded condition at Monongahela Memorial Hospital with chest injuries suffered in a rock fall Monday night in U. S. Steel Corp. Maple Creek Mine which killed Frank McKulka, 54, of Uniontown.

McKulka, an assistant mine foreman, was crushed in the roof fall at 7 p.m. At midnight his body still was in the mine.

Carried from the mine and taken to the hospital were Nagy; John Burns, 40, of New Salem, admitted in guarded condition with leg injuries, and John R. Evancheck, 54, of Uniontown, treated for minor injuries.
