

Trapped miners rescued

MINERAL, Va. (AP) — Three miners who were trapped 150 feet underground by a cave-in at a zinc mine were brought safely to the surface by rescuers early today. One suffered what were described as minor injuries.

Deputy Sheriff Louis Proffit of the Louisa County Sheriff's Department said the cave-in occurred at a mine operated by Piedmont Mineral Associates.

The three men, all from the Louisa County area, were identified as Horace Sherry, George Dickson and Roosevelt Groom, who was taken to the University of Virginia Hospital.
