

Two youths rescued from mine shaft

FLORENCE (AP) — A teen-ager from Florence was hospitalized Saturday after he and a companion spent about eight hours trapped in an abandoned mine shaft 12 miles east of Florence.

Dan Wall, 18, reportedly fell about 50 feet while he and Tim Harris, 17, also of Florence, were climbing in the mine in Eight Mile Canyon Thursday afternoon.

Wall was listed in stable condition at Community Hospital in Missoula. A spokesman said he was suffering from shock and had pain in the chest and pelvic areas.

Harris was hit by falling rock, but was not seriously hurt.
