

Man rescued from mine shaft

A 23-year-old Lakewood man was rescued and apparently was uninjured after he fell into a mine shaft on Cheyenne Mountain on Monday afternoon. Shannon Danley, right, apparently walked about 25 feet into the shaft and then fell about 30 feet down a vertical shaft. Danley's fiancée and a companion flagged down a passing deputy, who tried unsuccessfully to rescue Danley before calling for additional help around 4 p.m. He was brought to the surface at about 6:20 p.m. Danley suffered rope burns to his left hand. He apparently was searching the mine shaft for gold when he fell.
