

## 35 Rescued After Blast in Coal Mine

TERRE-HAUTE, Ind. (UP)—Thirty-five coal miners were trapped by an explosion in the Dresser coal mine last night, but all were rescued.

Mine officials said two men with second degree burns were taken to the Union hospital at Terre Haute. None of the other men were injured, said Dr. Cohen H. Luckette, mine physician.

Cause of the explosion was not known. A mine spokesman said all of the trapped men were on the night shift. He added that there were no dayshift workers in the mine when the explosion occurred.

The two burned men were identified as William Davidson, 53, and George Klermak, 41. The explosion occurred at 6:10 p.m., and mine officials said all of the men were out at 7 p.m.
