

TEN RESCUED FROM MINE SHAFT CAGE

Men Hauled From Car Jammed In
Ice Down 1200 Feet

WILKES-BARRE, Pa., Dec. 23.—
Ten workers in the Alden Coal Co.
colliery were rescued today from a
cage hanging precariously in a 1200
foot vertical shaft.

The cage was jammed against the
walls of the shaft by ice. The min-
ers were brought to the surface one
at a time with a block and tackle
arrangement.
