

TRAPPED MINER IS SAVED

Uniontown, Pa., Jan. 31 (INS).—Oran Kennedy, thirty-six-year-old miner, today owed his life to the fact that his fellow workers disregarded the danger of continuing rock falls and rescued him from beneath tons of rock which crashed from the ceiling of the Stambaugh workings of the Bortz Coal Company.

Tons of roof slate fell in the shaft in which Kennedy was working. A pit wagon broke the fall near the miner, however, and provided breathing space between the huge lumps of slate.

For two hours rescuers, constantly menaced by additional falls, went forward with their efforts until they reached Kennedy, who escaped with a fractured pelvis.
