

**Boys Killed in Mine Shaft.**

Two sons of Joseph Feit, aged ten and twelve, and Andrew Selakdichs, aged twelve, were killed at the Elba mine at Biwabik, Minn., while playing with a car which is used in the shaft. One of the boys turned the switch the wrong way, and the car crashed down the shaft opening, hurling the three boys to the bottom of the shaft, killing them instantly.
