

## Father, Son Saved From Death in Mine

Ashland, Pa. (AP) — A father and son, trapped in a makeshift mine since early Monday, were brought out today by rescuers.

"Thank God, I'm out of there," were the father's first words. His son was too weary to speak.

A physician said both Peter Shinkowsky, 48, Shenandoah, and Peter, Jr., 17, appeared to be in good condition.

The elder Shinkowsky's daughter, Mary, stood by, too tired to show emotion when the men were brought out. Her mother, who had kept an almost constant vigil for two days, was resting at home.

Rescuers at first had feared the men were dead.
