## 17 SAVED AS BAD AIR FLOODS MINE

Springfield, Ill., March 6.—Seventeen men, overcome by bad air, were rescued today from the Peabody mine at Riverton, a mining town near here, after reports of an explosion had been circulated. Presence of the bad air in the shaft is believed due to a windy shot last night in which a shot firer was overcome and a mine examiner injured.
