

Two Dead, Four Saved As Water Floods Mine

Pottsville, Pa., Nov. 23—(United News)—Two miners were drowned in a water-filled mine tunnel from which four others were rescued late today at the Brookside colliery, Philadelphia and Reading Coal & Iron Company operation near here.

A shot fired by the workers in a rock hole released an underground pocket of water. Charles Deibert, 23, and Simon Bohr, 36, both of Seudberg, near here, were drowned. Rescuers risked their lives in the tunnel to rescue the four trapped men, who waited for hours for the aid they knew was coming toward them.
