AMERICA CLEARS DECK FOR BATTLE, ROOSEVELT SAYS

**FDR Makes Third Plea To Lewis**

WASHINGTON, Oct. 27.—(AP)—President Roosevelt today made his third plea to John L. Lewis, leader of the United Mine Workers, to end the coal strike.

Mr. Roosevelt's plea was the first since he called on Lewis to end the strike on Oct. 15. He said that the nation was in a "shooting war" and that the coal strike was a "shooting challenge" to the United States.

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
