RESCUER DIES IN A MINE.

Shenandoah, Sept. 28.—Isaac James lost his life yesterday in rescuing two men in a colliery of the Lehigh Valley Coal Company. Jeremiah Mahoney and Charles Lewis were timbering the Buck Mountain slope, when a fall of top rock occurred, by which Lewis and Mahoney were almost covered. James immediately started the work of rescue, when a second fall occurred, killing him instantly. At Ellangowan Colliery Enoch Sopowicz was killed by a fall of coal.
