
TRAPPED MINER SAVED

MAHANOEY CITY, Pa., October 4 (AP).—Entombed 17 hours in a make-shift mountainside mine near here, Michael Lukash, 45, was rescued alive early today.

With his stepson and two other men, Lukash was engaged in abandoning the working yesterday because the coal had petered out. The walls collapsed as he was carrying out one of the few remaining sacks of fuel.

His companions escaped. Physicians said he apparently was little the worse for his experience.
