

19 Saved in Mine Flood Lead Effort To Rescue Mules

OKMULGEE, Okla., April 16.—Nineteen miners, rescued from the Wise coal mine near Henryetta, Okla., Thursday after being trapped by flood waters, turned rescuers yesterday in an effort to save two left underground.

Two mules in an entry that was flooded with 16 feet of water were believed to have drowned, but two others followed the miners to the level on which the men took refuge until they escaped to the surface.

The men, knowing what it means to be imprisoned underground, manned the pumps without pay to free the mine of water and hope to have the mules out by today.
