

Woman killed in landslide

LEADVILLE, Colo. (AP) — A 22-year-old local woman was killed Sunday when she was crushed in a rockslide at a Climax Molybdenum mine near here, a company spokesman said.

The spokesman said Charlene R. Salazar was working as a loader on a production crew when she was partially buried in the slide. Miss Salazar, who was preparing to clear a rock jam at the time of the incident, died at the scene, the spokesman, Terry Fitzsimmons, said.

Fitzsimmons said the area where the incident occurred was closed and the woman's death was under investigation by officials of the Colorado Bureau of Mines, the federal government and the company.
