

Three Men Trapped By Fire in Mine Are Rescued Alive

Wallace, Idaho, Sept. 19.—(AP.)—Three miners were rescued alive late today from a tunnel in the "Terrible Edith" Mine at Murray after they had been trapped for hours by fire which swept the mine portal. Rescuers from the Hecla Mine plunged through the fire until they reached the imprisoned men who were crouched behind a barricade.

The three were trapped in the silver-lead mine early today, when fire starting in the mine company's barn swept over all adjacent buildings, destroying the company headquarters building, the garage, bunk house, cook house, blacksmith shop and compressor. Damage to the buildings approached \$30,000.
