

Miner Rescued At Lonaconing After Cave In

**William Reiber, 49, Frac-
tures Leg; Local Man's
Foot Mangled In
Accident**

A Lonaconing miner, William Reiber, 49, of Douglas street, was rescued from the Maryland Fuel mine there this morning after being pinioned for two hours by a cave in of timber supports. The mine is owned by the Jenkins Coal Company.

Reiber, admitted to Memorial Hospital about 9:30 a. m., suffered a fractured right leg. According to hospital attaches Reiber was caught between the fallen timbers and a mine car. He was brought to the hospital by his foreman, Matyin Eichhorn, in an ambulance. His condition is "good."
