SLIDE IN SNOW REACHES 70 FEET

ELSON'S BLAST KILLS 36 BODIES ARE RECOVERED, AS MANY MISSING

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Couple Rescued After Terrible Experience

RICHMOND, Utah, Feb. 18.—(AP)—A force of more than 100 men, working under the direct supervision of Frank A. Wadsworth, superintendent of the Utah-Powhatan Mining company, today announced that they had recovered the bodies of 36 men who were killed in a landslide which occurred on the night of Feb. 17.

Approximately 60 others are missing. Twelve survivors are in the hospital and more than a score recovered first aid treatment. The snow was about 10 feet deep and conditions were good for the search.

Night and day shifts were kept at work until the entire ground had been covered. Wadsworth said he estimated two more days will be required to make the search.

And then we may miss some, he said. "We may not know the exact number of dead until spring. One unidentified body was recovered."

Only 15 of the known dead had been identified and there was the possibility that the 37 unidentified bodies were of persons killed as well as missing and buried under the snow.

The rescue workers, numbering their efforts at the 77 unidentified bodies, said they were confident that the bodies of the missing men would be recovered.

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Of the numerous fatalities named in the Countess Barring, the names of the 36 men who were killed in the landslide were listed. The names of the missing men were also listed.
